

Focus On Prevention: Place Based Change

The following are bills in the 2011 session that address prevention through place based change.

<i>Bill No./ Author</i>	<i>Summary</i>	<i>Sponsor</i>
AB 441 (Monning)	Building Healthy Communities: Includes health and equity criteria in the guidelines the state uses when advising local governments on land use and transportation planning and development.	CPEHN
AB 727 (Mitchell)	Healthy Food Procurement: Requires that food purchased for consumption or sale on state property (e.g. vending machines, institutions, cafeterias, and concessioner contracts) meet minimum nutritional standards.	CPEHN
AB 516 (V.M. Perez)	Safe Routes to Schools: Requires the state to consider as part of its criteria for awarding local grants to construction of bicycle and pedestrian safety and traffic calming projects as part of its “Safe Routes to Schools” initiative, the degree of specific public participation and the benefit to disadvantaged communities.	
AB 70 (Monning)	Community Transformation Grants: Requires California’s HHS Agency to direct departments to apply for federal community transformation grants and to make information available to local government agencies, public health departments, school districts, state and local nonprofit organizations and Indian tribes.	
AB 405 (Solorio)	Joint-Use – Post Secondary Education: Would authorize the State Allocation Board to fund joint-use projects to construct facilities on community college campuses.	
SB 244 (Wolk)	Colonias Planning: Requires cities or counties when reviewing and updating their general plans to address the presence of unincorporated communities and to update the program of action relating to these communities.	California Rural Legal Assistance Foundation, Policy Link
SB 535 (De Leon)	Climate change and equity: Creates a Community Benefits Fund to direct a portion of the revenues generated through the implementation of AB 32 to help Californians who are least able to confront the expected impacts of the climate crisis at a local level	NRDC, Coalition for Clean Air, Ella Baker Center
